This holiday season, we will pay homage to some of Columbus' most forgotten landmarks by asking architects, landscape architect, designers, students and community members to revisit the past and reimagine these iconic structures for the future.

Details for your model in our 2024 exhibit, *Columbus' Forgotten Landmarks Reborn* are below:

- Up to 15 teams may purchase a 12"x18" plot along the train line — to display their design to recreate one of Columbus' forgotten landmarks.
- Models will be constructed with all white Lego™ bricks (clear for glass is acceptable) — no shorter than 24" and no taller than 48". Lego™ sets to be used for your model are available at CFAD to be picked up or can be delivered to your firm.
- Please plan to join us at the Center for Architecture and Design (CFAD) for an opening reception to celebrate the unveiling on Friday, Dec. 6, from 5:30–7:30pm.

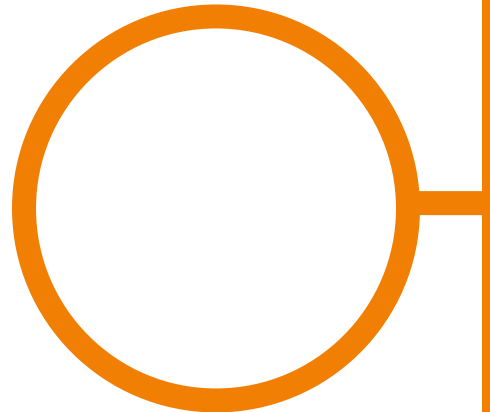
